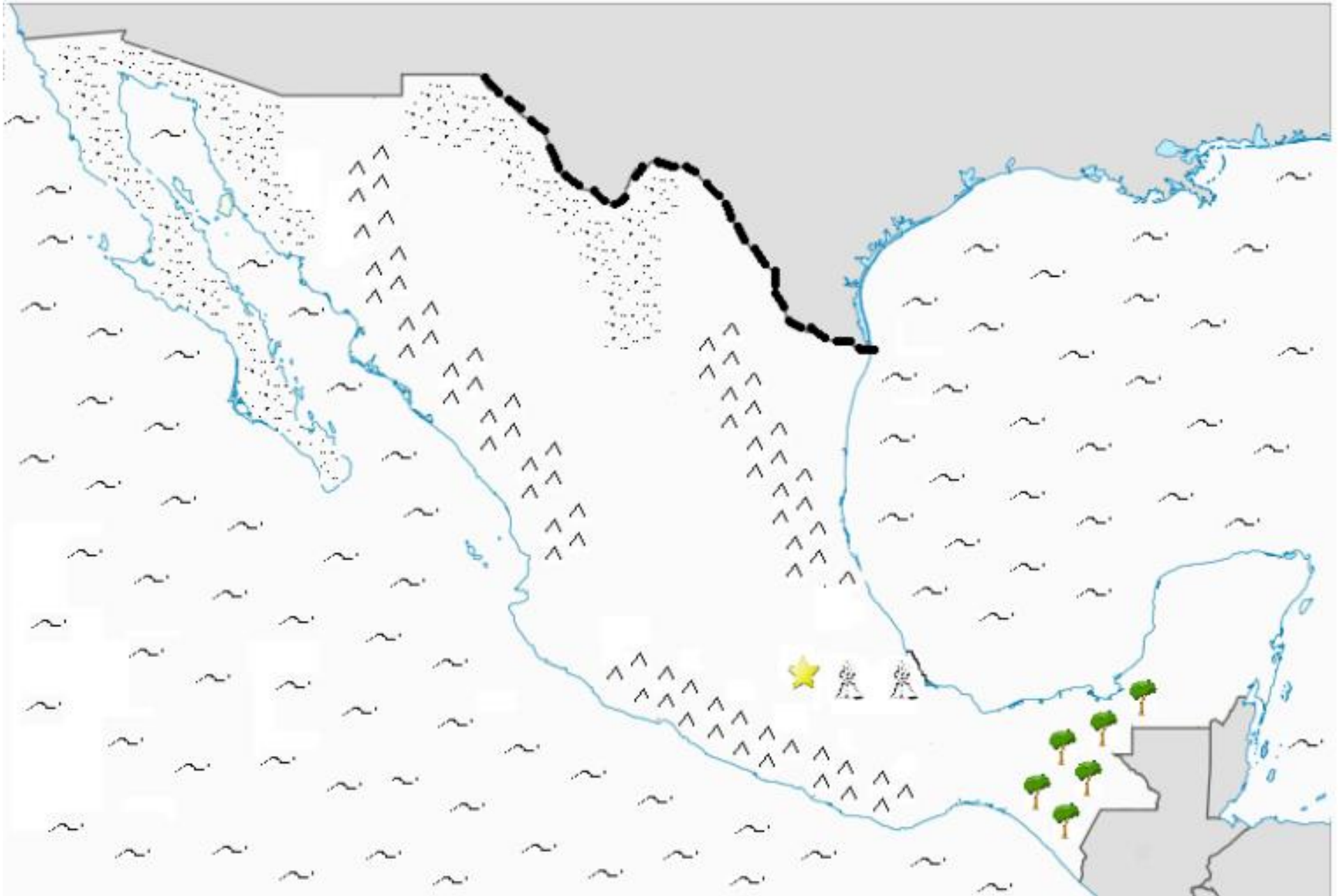

My Map of Mexico

Directions: Let's design our own 3D versions of a physical map of Mexico. Use glue to attach the objects on top of the pictures on the map (use the key below for help). A map "key" helps readers identify places on a map. Using an index card, students should design their own "map key" to show what each object on the map represents.

Objects for designing the map:

- sand = desert
- blue ribbon/yarn = river
- tissue paper balls = mountains
- tissue paper with gold glitter = volcanoes
- green foam pieces = rainforest
- star sticker = capital city
- blue coloring = ocean

Original Map Key:

dots = desert

dashed line = river

triangles = mountains

exploding mountains = volcanoes

trees = rainforest

star = capital city

wavy lines = ocean
